- E** case (endings) of nouns, adjectives, possessive pronouns, etc.
- C** case of articles, personal pronouns
- T** tense
- G** gender (of noun, pronoun or article)
- N** number (plural vs. singular)
- WO** word order (in many cases: verb position)
- W** word choice, word missing
- prep.** wrong preposition (unnecessary or missing)
- art.** article: unnecessary, missing or choice (indefinite vs. definite)
- pron.** wrong or missing pronoun

- V** verb form, verb ending
- SV** subject -verb agreement
- refl.** reflexive verb (in most cases: refl. pronoun wrong or missing)
- sep.** verb with separable prefix
- sub.** wrong subjunctive (unnecessary or missing)
- PT** wrong past tense form
- PP** wrong or missing past participle
- aux.** wrong or missing auxiliary (present perfect, past perfect, future tense)
- P** wrong or missing passive voice

- sp.** spelling (incl. capitalization and *Umlaute*)
- k** *Kommas*

- st.** style (colloquialisms, idioms, too formal, etc.)
- _st._** phrase too simple or not specific enough: rephrase
- __?__** meaning unclear and/or major syntax problems; rewrite entire phrase!!!
- +** very nice phrase or word
