  - A. Scenic paints
    - 1. Brilliant Colors
    - 2. Can be thinned down
  - B. Dry Pigment
    - 1. Cheap
    - 2. needs binder
    - 3. custom colors are easy
    - 4. Mess to store
    - 5. not very durable
  - C. Casein
    - 1. Can SMELL when it goes bad
    - 2. Concentrated
    - 3. very matte finish
  - D. Latex
    - 1. Good bonding
    - 2. Flexible
    - 3. non scenic often has less dye
    - 4. can be tinted
  - E. Vinyl Acrylic
    - 1. Similar to Latex
    - 2. Very high adhesion and flexibility
    - 3. Can be watered down to a glaze
  - F. Aniline Dye
    - 1. Brilliant
    - 2. Transparent
    - 3. can be extremely poisonous
  - G. Clear Finishes
